RESERVATION AND RELAXATION POLICY FOR ADMISSION INTO POST GRADUATE AND FOUR YEAR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES, MUC, MAJULI

RESERVATION OF SEATS:

1. Reservation of seats on various grounds:

(I) Statutory Reservation:

Scheduled Caste (S.C.)	7%
Scheduled Tribes, Plains (S.T.P.) Scheduled Tribes, Hills (S.T.H.)	10% 5%

Note: Caste Certificates must be issued by the competent authorities and countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner of the District concerned. Except statutory reservations, other kinds of reservations are not applicable for research programmes, viz. Ph.D. and M.Phil. programmes. In case of statutory reservation candidates domicile of Assam is mendatory.

(II) Economically Weaker Sections (EWS):

There shall be 10% seats to be created supernumerarily on the intake capacity of the concerned academic programme for the Economical Weaker Section (EWS) conditions.

The eligibility norms for the EWS candidates shall be as per the recent Government of Assam Office Memorandum or Notifications.

(III) Differently-abled:

5% of the total seats in all the Academic Programmes are reserved for the differently- abled students/persons with benchmark disabilities. Candidates applying for consideration under this category must submit Medical Certificate issued by the Joint Director of Health Services of the district concerned and countersigned on verification by a Senior Medical Officer. Those who on the pretext of being very negligibly differently-abled by visual deficiency and the like

shall not be eligible for consideration under this reserved category.

Here, "person with benchmark disability" means a person with not less than forty percent of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority;

In the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 the list of disabilities has been expanded from 7 to 21 conditions. These are as follows:

- (i) Blindness;
- (ii) Low Vision;
- (iii) Leprosy Cured Persons;
- (iv) Hearing Impairment (deaf and hard of hearing);
- (v) Locomotor Disability;
- (vi) Dwarfism;
- (vii) Intellectual Disability;
- (viii) Mental illness;
- (ix) Autism Spectrum Disorder;
- (x) Cerebral Palsy;
- (xi) Muscular Dystrophy;
- (xii) Chronic Neurological Conditions;
- (xiii) Specific Learning Disabilities;
- (xiv) Multiple Sclerosis;
- (xv) Speech and Language Disability;
- (xvi) Thalassemia;
- (xvii) Hemophilia;
- (xviii) Sickle Cell Disease;
- (xix) Multiple Disabilities (including Deaf & Blindness);
- (xx) Acid Attack Survivors and
- (xxi) Parkinson's Disease.

(IV) Extra Curricular Activities:

(A) Sports: A total of two seats for all the Departments taken together.

Eligibility - Must have represented any University/State (Assam) in any of the Olympic disciplines or Cricket conducted by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi/National Sports Federation as recognized by the Sports Authority of India (SAI)/Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

Participation in the above-mentioned games and sports must not be earlier than three years before the academic session in which admission is sought.

The candidates may have to appear in a Qualifying Test in the concerned discipline.]

(B) Art/Culture: A total of two seats.

Eligibility - Proficiency in Fine Arts or performing Arts, as evidenced by participation at the recognized Regional/National level competitions State (Assam).

The candidates may have to appear in a Qualifying Test in the concerned discipline.

(C) Literary: A total of two seats.

Eligibility - Certificate of winning award/prizes in literary competitions of Inter University/National level **Or** having standard published work. (Selection will be made by a committee to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor).

(D) N.C.C.: A total of two seats.

Eligibility - Representation of the State (of Assam) in the Republic Day Parade in New Delhi sponsored by the Regional Directorate, N.C.C. or having N.C.C. 'C' certificate.

(E) N.S.S: A total of two seats.

Eligibility: Candidates applying under NSS Quota for admission into the various Post Graduate Academic Programmes offered at Dibrugarh University must have NSS completion certificate issued from the NSS Cell, Dibrugarh University. The applicant must possess the minimum qualifying marks in his/her TDC final examination as per rules of the University.

However, the candidates having the minimum qualifying criteria (NSS Completion Certificate and minimum Qualification marks) will be selected on the basis of possession of the certificates placed below in order of weightage:

- 1. National Level NSS Awardees
- 2. State Level NSS Awardees
- 3. Member of the Indian Youth Delegation Team (International Youth Exchange)
- 4. Republic Day Camp Participants
- 5. Participation in various National Level NSS Camps and Programmes
- 6. Participation in various State Level NSS Camps and Programmes/ University Level NSS Programmes

In case of equal weightage between two candidates on the final selection will be selected on the basis of marks obtained in the TDC final examinations.

(V) Tea and Ex-tea Community:

A total of three seats (one in each Department). Eligibility - Must be permanent resident of Assam.

Note:

- a. In an academic programme, not more than one seat from a category [except statutory reservations] shall be admissible.
- b. The number of seats reserved under non-statutory reservations shall be filled in subject to the condition that not more than 7% of the total unreserved seats shall be allotted to the concerned academic programme as regards the aforementioned clauses.
- c. Selection shall be made on the basis of merit in the concerned Entrance Test on a competitive basis.
- d. Candidates seeking admission under Clause 1 (I), (II), (III), (IV) and (V) shall have to fill an additional prescribed form which shall be available in the website of Majuli University of Culture.
