Greetings from the Majuli University of Culture, Majuli, Assam!

It gives me immense pleasure to submit before you the Second Annual Report of the Majuli University of Culture for the years 2023-24.

The Majuli University of Culture is a holistic, multi and inter disciplinary higher educational hub of studies and research in different disciplines with special focus on culture, cultural preservation, growth and progress with quality and optimal learning environments and support, effective governance with other infrastructure facilities as defined in the National Education Policy 2020, Government of India. The University will take up the human ecology and environment of this part of India, its colourful cultures, rich folklore, language, and the intellectual heritage to understand them academically and cultivate them for the progress of our society. The uniqueness of Majuli in terms of social and geographical entity with its rich cultural heritage has been derived from the tradition inherited from Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva and his disciple Mahapurusha Madhavadeva interwoven with the rich floral fabrics of the pristine cultures of the Misings, Deuris and Kacharis. The establishment of the University on the bank of the Luit river, the old channel of the Brahmaputra, flowing on the north of the island encompassing varied groups of population with their colourful cultural life, presupposes a unique site by itself.

The island society also boasts of its traditional Vaishnava institutions called *Satra* of which the grand ones with celibate inmates, such as the Auniati, Dakhinpat, Garamur, Kamalabari and others (like Bengenaati, Chamaguri, Bhogpur etc.) still govern the moral and spiritual life of Assam to a large degree. Preservatories of extensive tangible and intangible cultural resources these *Satras* along with the island's varied topographical, demographical, ethno-cultural and natural landscape areas, have made the island district a natural museum for mankind.

A Brief Account of the University (1/3)

- ***The Majuli University of Culture Act***
 - No. LG L.5 I nU7 D.- The Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor on 16th October, 2017 is hereby published for general information. ASSAM ACT NO. XXXVII OF 2017 and received the assent of the Governor on 16th October, 2017.
- ***Declaration of Establishment of the Majuli University of Culture***
 - The then Chief Minister of Assam, Sjt. Sarbananda Sonowal laid the foundation stone of the Majuli University of Culture on 13.07.2018 to be built up with a total budget of 300 Crore investment by the Government of Assam.
- ***The First Vice-Chancellor Appointed***
 - The First Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Dambarudhar Nath was appointed by Hon'ble Governor of Assam and he resumed the Office on 21.09.2019.
- ***Empowerment to Award Degrees***
 - The UGC empowered the University to award degrees vide F. No. 9-10/2020(CPP-I/PU) dated 10th August 2020
- ***The University website commissioned***
 - The University Website www.muoc.ac.in was inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam Sri Sarbananda Sonowal on 27.11.2020.
- ***The Allotment of Land***
 - Two plots of land, one measuring 100 *bigha* at village Manika Pathar and the other 5 *bigha* at village Barun Chitadar allotted by the District administration which was handed over to the PWD for construction of building.

A Brief Account of the University (2/3)

- ***Grant for Transit Campus***
 - The Government accorded administrative approval for an amount **Rs.1,79,47,623/-** for the construction of a transit buildings (Part I) consisting of VC residence, Grade IV quarters, 4 classrooms with teacher's common rooms, earth filing etc.
- ***Administrative Approval for Construction of Guest House and Classroom Building***
 - The Government accorded administrative approval for an amount **Rs.2,31,00,650/-** for the construction of Guest House & Class Room Building (Part II).
- ***Design, Plan and Estimate of the Main Campus***
 - The Design Plan of the University has been prepared by the firm **Hiten Sethi & Associates** under the supervision of the Chief Engineer's office (PWD, Building), Guwahati.
- ***MoU signed with Manohar Jalan Foundation for Endowment Awards***
 - An MoU was signed between Majuli University of Culture and Manohar Jalan Foundation, Dibrugarh for creation of two endowment awards for the students on merit and mean basis on 29.11.2022.
- ***Government sanctioned 27 Nos. of Teaching and Non-teaching posts***
 - The Government sanctioned 37 nos. of Post PC/HE/Misc/43/2020/256 vide Letter no. dated 07/10/2021.
- ***Government passed the First Statutes***
 - The First Statutes of the University notified by the Government in the Assam Gazette on 30th June, 2021.

A Brief Account of the University (3/3)

- ***Government passed the Majuli University of Culture (Amendment) Act***
- The Majuli University of Culture (Amendment) Act has been passed by the Assam Legislative Assembly on 13/08/2021.
- ***Academic Session of the University Started***
- The first batch of students enrolled to the Post Graduate Programmes in Assamese and History along with Post Graduate Diploma and Certificate Courses for the session 2021-2022. The then Hon'ble chief Minister of Assam Sjt. Sarbananda Sonowal inaugurated the same on 03.02.2021. Due to lack of own buildings, classes started at Pub Majuli College, Majuli.
- ***MoU signed with Manohar Jalan Foundation for Endowment Awards***
- An MoU was signed between Majuli University of Culture and Manohar Jalan Foundation, Dibrugarh for creation of two endowment awards for the students on merit and mean basis on 29.11.2022.
- ***Foundation Stone Laying Ceremony of the Permanent Buildings of the Main Campus***
- Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam laid the Foundation Stone of the Permanent Buildings of the Main Campus at Manika Pathar, Garamur, Majuli on 11.12.2022
- ***Classes have been shifted from Pub Majuli College to Transit Campus of the University***
- The classes of the academic programmes were shifted from Pub Majuli College to Transit Campus at Chitadarchuk on 26.12.2022.
- ***Administration shifted from Kamalabari Block Development Office to Transit Campus***
- The Administrative Branches of the University including the Office of the Vice-Chancellor was shifted from Kamalabari Block Development Office to the Transit Campus on 14.02.2023.
- During the FY 2023-2024, the Government of Assam granted another financial aid of Rs.2.14,17,200/- for classroom, teacher's common room and Vice-Chancellor's Office buildings on the Transit campus of the University. The buildings are under construction and expected to be completed by June 2024.

Report of the Registrar



Although the Majuli University of Culture was established in 2017 with the enactment of the Majuli University of Culture Act, 2017 by the Government of Assam, the academic journey of the University was started in the year 2021 with introduction of two post graduate programmes, namely- Assamese and History. As the University had not its own academic buildings at that time, the classes of the academic session 2021-2022 were held in Pub Majuli College, Majuli and that was continued till January, 2023. However, with the grant by the Government of Assam, the Transit Campus of the University has been developed at Chitadarchuk, Garamur, Majuli with limited infra-structure and the academic departments have been shifted to this campus. Later on, in mid-February, the administrative offices of the University were also shifted from the Kamalabari Block Development Office to the Transit Campus accommodating all the branches of administration in a building actually constructed for the future guest house purpose. Accordingly, we have also procured our necessary furniture, equipment etc. with the grant-in aid sanctioned by the Government for the specific purposes.

The University had started the recruitment process for the various teaching and non-teaching posts in November, 2021 as per approval of the Government of Assam, which has been completed in January, 2024.

Keeping aside the limitations, challenges and disadvantages, Majuli University of Culture has been striving to offer quality education with positive perspectives for the future. Besides, teaching and counselling by regular faculties of the University, classes by guest faculties are arranged to provide extensive exposure in the relevant academic fields.

The Majuli University of Culture is concerned and responsive to the global perspectives of higher education and the call of the National Education Policy, 2020. In compliance to that we have introduced Five-Year Integrated Masters (FYUGP + 1 Year Masters) Programme with effect from the academic session 2023-2024. We have also started Ph.D. Programmes in Assamese, History and Performing Arts from the same session. Besides, the regular degree programmes, the University initiates the process for introduction of certificate and short-term programmes on (a) Post Graduate Diploma in Yoga & Health Keeping (b) Post Graduate Diploma in Mask Making & Sculpture, (c) Post Graduate Diploma in Manuscript Studies (d) Six monthly Certificate Course on Mising Language, etc. in collaboration with various institutes and organizations. The University has also requested the Government of Assam to accord necessary amendments of the Acts and Statutes so that it can move towards a leading multi-disciplinary University will all avenues of knowledge and skills that are required by the 21st Century societies.

Report of the Registrar

The University fraternity believes on all-round holistic development of the learners and with that perspective, we endeavour to provide all possible exposures to our students. The faculties are involved in innovative teaching-learning and facilitate students for exposure, experimental and experiential learning within their regular courses of studies. The Student's Brilliance Conventions organized to show-case their hidden talents on a bigger platform. With the initiatives of the IQAC, the University has organized collaborative student-exchange programmes with different colleges and institutes. The Career Counselling and Guidance Cell has organized a One-Week Crash Course on APSC and Combined Services. A good number of study materials are receiving from NEXT IAS, New Delhi for the UPSC aspirants of the University.

From inception, strong community- Institute interface is one of the positive aspects of the Majuli University of Culture. The University has been facilitated with a Girl's Hostel (namely- *Me:po Okum Girl's Hostel*) on public-private partnership basis through a MoU with Sri Horen Narah, a local entrepreneur of Chitadarchuk, Garamur, Majuli, Assam. The University has been running its Boy's Hostel in a building of the *Garamur Satra* generously allowed to use by paying the electricity expenditures only. The Mahadeo Jalan Foundation of Dibrugarh has donated a corpus fund of Rs.25 Lacs to the University to institute Endowment Awards for the eligible students from the interest accrued.

It may be pertinent here to mention that the growth and development of the University has just found its track to move with the able leadership of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. The processes for development, which were initiated by the former Vice-Chancellor are now taken for accomplishment by compromising or contrasting with many newer challenges. The infra-structure of the present campus (transit) is yet to be fully functional. Construction of the houses, provisions for external electrifications, etc. are yet to be completed and handed over to the University. The permanent campus of the University is under construction at the Manika Pathar, Garamur, Assam under the supervision of the *Loka Nirman* (PWD) Department of the Government of Assam. We sincerely hope that with generous support from the Government, the construction works will be completed within the stipulated time.

Report of the Registrar

As a new establishment and venture of the Government, the Majuli University of Culture has lots of limitations and challenges from all sides so far as the need of a modern University is concerned. But, keeping all the constraints aside, we are committed to flourish and bound to accelerate its relentless pace of progress.

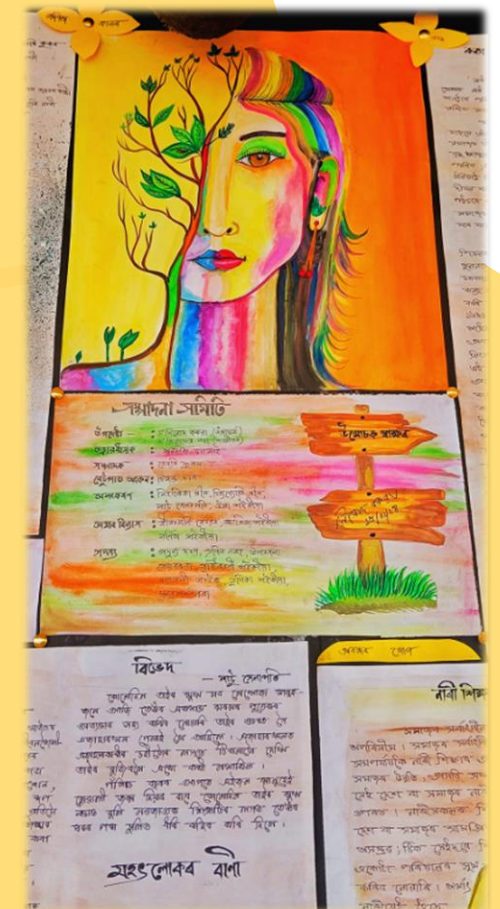

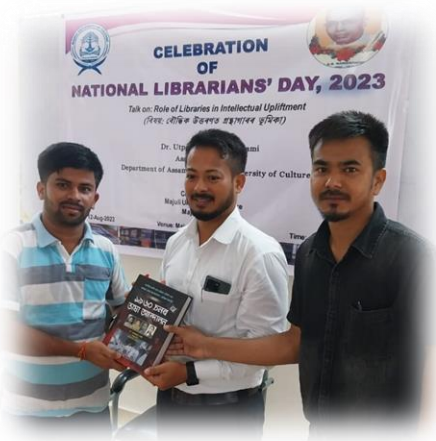
3. Installation of Surveillance System has been installed.

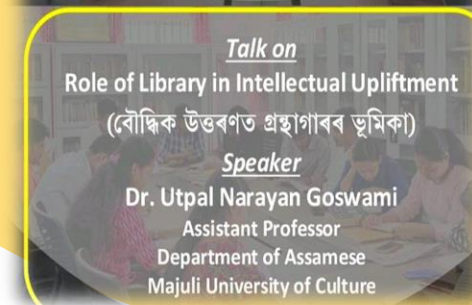
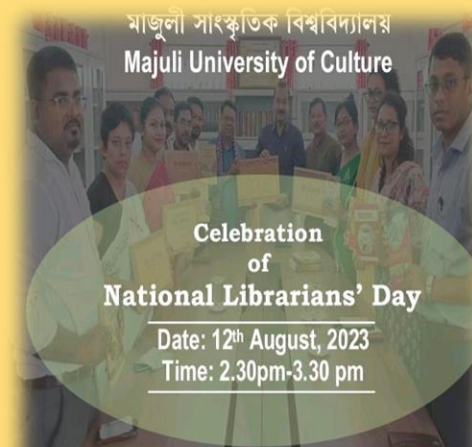

National Academic Depository (NAD): Examination Branch

Besides, the regular activities of the Examination Branch, the National Academic Depository (NAD) is born out of an initiative by MoE to provide a 24X7 online depository to Academic institutions to store and publish their academic awards. Mr. Anirban Dutta, Assistant Controller of Examinations has been appointed as the Nodal Officer of the NAD Cell of the Majuli University of Culture. The digital depository not only ensures easy access to and retrieval of an academic award but also validates and guarantees its authenticity and safe storage. For this purpose, all the Academic Institutions are requested to upload the Academic Awards/ Records of their Institutions on DigiLocker.

Taking this initiative forward, the Registrar, MUC appointed the Assistant Controller of Examinations, as Nodal Officer of National Academic Depository (NAD) on 2nd February, 2023 for a tenure of 3 years to priorities the process of Award Uploading of Majuli University of Culture. Accordingly, the Nodal Officer initiated the process for Registration of the University in the NAD portal and on 3rd February, 2023, Registration was completed. To facilitate in the entire task of NAD, Registrar, MUC constituted a committee with three members on 20th February, 2023. The first meeting of this Committee was held on 10th March, 2023. In this meeting, templates for various courses were approved for uploading Students data. As per resolution of this meeting, Registrar, MUC assigned additional duty to Dr. Pankajyoti Borah, Asstt. Professor, Assamese, Mr. Dhruba Jyoti Borah, Sr. Assistant and Mr. Tapas Protim Borah, Jr. Assistant as Award Verifier, Certificate Verifier and Award Publisher respectively.

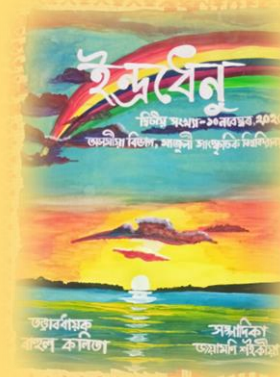

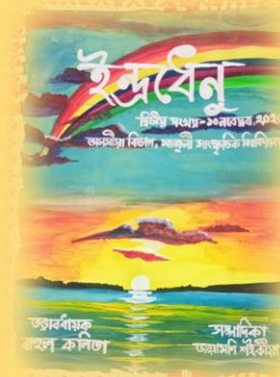
